



Negative pressure Wound Therapy unit and dressing

Negative Pressure Wound Therapy (NPWT) that helps to heal your patient's wounds faster with fewer infections. It uses gentle vacuum pressure to remove fluid and infectious material from your patient's wounds. It also helps to draw the edges of your patient's wounds together and promotes the formation and growth of new tissue.

A special dressing is applied to the wound by a trained health care professional. The dressing is then connected to the pump which applies the vacuum. The dressing is changed every 72 hours. The canister, which collects the drainage can be changed weekly or sooner depending on the amount of drainage. We work closely with WoundCC.org in educating for this therapy process
